Lot Numbers

Emergency vehicles can now make their way into our park unassisted (without being met by someone to lead them in), as a result, it is necessary to have your lot number on your lot, easily visible from the road; this is also a 911 requirement. If the vehicle has to search for your site, it could delay receiving necessary treatment in an emergency. This is also something our Park Manager has been asking everyone to do as it is difficult for maintenance staff to find your lot if there's no number visible to them. It is equally difficult for the Building Committee to come by your lot to look at a building permit. **Please, put a sign on your lot that shows the lot number, visible from the road.**

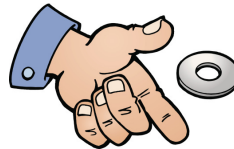
