## Lot Numbers

This is also something our Park Manager has been asking everyone to do as it is difficult for maintenance staff to find your lot if there's no number visible to them. It is equally difficult for the Building Committee to come by your lot to look at a building permit. **Please, put a sign on your lot that shows the lot number, visible from the road.**

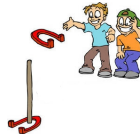

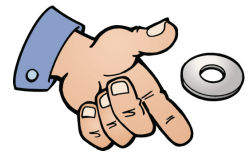
